#### Changes to screening requirements in DECD

DECD's relevant history screening requirements have changed, effective immediately, to make it easier for parents and guardians to volunteer their time.

- Screenings are no longer required for parents or guardians if their child is in direct receipt of their services (excluding overnight camps, billets and homestays).
- Parents or guardians who are governing council members do not require screening unless the governing council is the employing authority for an out of school hours care service.

It is pleasing to see some relaxing of the requirements to make it easier for parents to volunteer in our school. We will still require screenings for Campus wide programs. If you need more information or unsure if you need a DCSI clearance, please contact Jane Dye.
