Dear Parents / Caregivers,

Earlier this year we introduced whole school agreements in English and Mathematics as part of our numeracy and literacy strategy. This strategy aims to build the learning power of students by increasing their ability to use high-level thinking skills and apply what they have learned in new and increasingly complex situations. In short, supporting them to become **powerful learners**.

Powerful learners have the curiosity, creativity and confidence to:

- actively participate in their learning
- make decisions based on sound evidence
- skillfully solve problems
- deal proactively with new situations
- communicate effectively in a variety of forms
- collaborate with others.

Powerful learners also have a 'growth mindset': the belief that they are capable of learning and achieving with effort.

10 What Questions to Develop a Growth Mindset in Children

1. What did you do today that made you think hard?
2. What happened today that made you keep on going?
3. What can you learn from this?
4. What mistake did you make that taught you something?
5. What did you try hard at today?
6. What strategy are you going to try now?
7. What will you do to challenge yourself today?
8. What will you do to improve your work?
9. What will you do to improve your talent?
10. What will you do to solve this problem?
